Chan Hubbard has extended a drain and the cost is \$750.00. The drain pipe is too small to handle the volume and is undermining the surrounding soil.

Chan has estimated the cost of replacing 55 gallon drums used as a drain that are deteriorating to be over 2,000. His estimate for this job has impacted an add-on job of Mike Miller with Pisgah Asphalt Paving, Inc. Mr. Miller will not level up the 50 ft by 8 ft area at this time. Pisgah Asphalt will begin tar and gravel of 2/10 of a mile on Monday between 3 and 4 p.m., weather permitting. Cost is \$9,920.00. Cost of area to be leveled (50 ft by 8 ft) was \$1,225.00.
