Treasurer's Report

Reviewed YTD budget. There is approximately \$10,084 in remaining funds, which includes funds approved for resurfacing the stretch of road below Taylor's Curve where the culvert was replaced.

The Board also reviewed the draft 2020 budget. The Board will request that we carry over the \$3700 approved for road resurfacing to the 2020 Budget.

Roads Report

Two major road/drainage repairs for 2019 – the landslide along Falcon Road that was reseeded & stabilized and the culvert replacement on PFD below Taylor's Curve. Chan has ordered ice melt to have on hand. The drainage improvement on the back side of PFD has been completed. Chan has also completed all ditch clearing.

Other Business

A property owner who was recently sent a notice of covenant violations attended the meeting to discuss the violations noted by the Board. Each of the covenant issues cited was discussed, and a verbal agreement to bring the property into compliance by the end of the year was reached.

The Board entertained a request from a property owner to subdivide two of his lots. After careful review of Article X of the Declaration of Restrictive Covenants, the Board unanimously decided that Article X prohibited an owner from subdividing their lots.

Reviewed draft agenda and made a few minor changes. Discussed logistics and assigned specific tasks to each Board member. We will have copies of all financial documents to be reviewed, ballot sheets and snow removal forms available for attendees.
